

Opening:

- Melissia called the meeting to order at 5:32 PM
- The board introduced themselves to the group
- Melissia shared the 2024-2025 PTO goals. They are as follows:
  - To build trust within our community, demonstrate integrity, reliability, and commitment in all our actions.
  - Maintain transparency with regular communication. Communicate openly and take responsibility for making necessary improvements. Keep everyone informed about PTO activities, decisions, and volunteer opportunities.
  - Encourage diverse participation. Promote open dialogue and promote participation from everyone in our community. Set clear expectations for volunteers. Provide clear guidelines and make sure everyone understands their roles and responsibilities. Make sure all members of our school community feel valued.

Items for Discussion:

- Melissia reviewed the recommended changes to the Bylaws. There was a discussion about Partners in Education. When the discussion was finished a vote was taken and the changes to the Bylaws were approved by a majority vote.
- Crystal reviewed the budget for 2024-2025. A vote was taken and the budget was approved by a majority vote.
  - It was also explained that we will be doing Boosterthon again this year. The contract was signed last year. The goal will be to raise \$35,000 for outdoor improvements. We will be speaking to parents to see what they are interested in. Would also like to use funds for the teachers from this money.



- Dr. Webley spoke and thanked parents for coming and encouraged parents to come to the general meetings. She also explained the School Advisory Council and encouraged parents to join and attend the meetings.
- Melissa presented project updates. They were as follows:
  - Fans: The PTO donated funds to have this done. Without our knowledge, OCPS put it on hold because they will be installing fans. This could take 1-3 years to happen, so the school has put a request in to get those done with the funds PTO has provided.
  - The basketball court has been resurfaced thanks to the 2023-2024 board
  - Behind the scenes project updates. We have selected a teacher liaison, Mrs. Lobue. There have been spirit nights scheduled by Allyson and she is working on more. New volunteer process and created committees. QR code magnets provided by a sponsor (we still have room for more sponsors). Working on a cup design for the fence. New cougar costume. Bringing back the Birthday Book Club.
- Melissia presented the calendar and a copy was given to those in attendance. It is also updated on the Facebook group and the PTO website (www.kce-pto.com).
- Sam explained that volunteers need to be Additions approved. There is a QR code on the magnets passed out.
- Jennie Clarke (Spirit Wear Committee Chair) shared that there is a preorder available for new spirit wear and a QR code was given.




